- 1. All archers must be experienced in the use of the English longbow and must also be a member of a recognised club or organisation that shoots the English longbow.
- 2. During the competition, competitors must wear footwear, clothing and headwear appropriate to the 14th to 16th century. We draw your attention to the fact that obviously modern shoes will not be accepted and that men and women over 14 must wear their hair covered
- 3. The competition is open to traditional English longbows only
- 4. Arrows must be wooden with feather fletchings. Points must be field/target piles. In addition, you will need 6 blunts, temporary rubber over metal will not be accepted
- 5. Bring as many standard arrows as you can shoot in 1 minute (speed shoot).
- 6. 20 bonus points per day will be awarded for self-nocked arrows
- 7. There is a maximum bow weight of 60 lb
- 8. No sight aids should be used on the bow or string
- 10. Glasses for vision correction are permitted. Sunglasses are not permitted whilst competing
